Potential Questions/Comments/Activities/Games:

- 3. Create a game that encourages interaction between all of the people in the Lego Set and allows them to change roles.
- 4. Talk about what the people look like. Does your child know people who look like each of the people in the set?

Continuing the Conversation

Talk to your child about how they are playing with their Lego people and whether or not they see similar scenes in their lives. So, if people of different races and genders are playing together in the Lego creations, talk about when they see this in their own lives (at school, at the park, walking around). Point out when this is not the case and why this might be (in an age-appropriate way). Take notice of how your child is playing with the Legos. Is a person of a particular race always in charge? If you see patterns, point them out to your child and examine why your child may be playing this way. What models do they have in their lives? Encourage/set up playdates with children of different races and encourage them to play with the Legos (they probably won't need it!). Pay attention to how they play together.
